Members are selected for their expertise, interest, willingness to attend meetings or as an affected stakeholder. Examples include representatives of interest groups, transportation agencies, minorities, persons with disabilities, or representatives of geographical areas, such as neighborhood associations. All committee members will have an equal voice in deliberations. The CAC typically meets eight times a year on Thursday mornings in the 1st Floor Community Room of the City/School Administration Center starting at 7:30 a.m. and generally last no longer than one hour. Please note that this form and all information provided is subject to the open records laws of the State of South Dakota. If you are appointed for a position, your nomination is subject to confirmation by the MPO's Executive Policy Committee and the information you provide on this form will then be available to the public and posted on the MPO's website.
