Dear Secretary Chao:

The Rapid City Area Metropolitan Planning Organization strongly supports the South Dakota Department of Transportation's Nationally Significant Freight and Highway Projects (INFRA) grant application to reconstruct the I-90 La Crosse Street Interchange costing approximately \$13 million.

The proposed project rebuilds a 1983 interchange constrained by adjacent development to a modern diverging diamond configuration. The interchange serves a major retail area in Rapid City connected to a huge rural trade area including western South Dakota, northeastern Wyoming, northwestern Nebraska, and the nearby Ellsworth Air Force Base. It will also better serve the residents of Rapid City. The interchange is on the National Highway Freight Network, National Highway System, and the State Preferential Truck Network.

This INFRA project supports economic vitality by improving rural-urban connectivity and is a project that highlights the importance of the Rural Opportunities to Use Transportation for Economic Success (ROUTES) Initiative.
